1 Job Description

- 1.1 Open positions: Senior Urban Designer (with more than 10 years of experience), who might also be working on architectural design projects from time to time.
- 1.2 Hiring condition: Full-time employee.
- 1.3 Language skills: English-Vietnamese (bilingual, business level) .
- 1.4 Positions to fill: Ho Chi Minh City (HCMC).
- 1.5 Office locations: NSVN offices in HCMC. (Rm # 1004-A, 10F, Zen Plaza, 54-56 Nguyen Trai Street, Ben Thanh Ward, District 1, Ho Chi Minh City) (MAP)
- 1.6 Monthly Salary guide:
 - * Senior Architect: 33,000,000 45,000,000 VND per month
- 1.7 Salaries are commensurate with the Candidate's abilities and experience. Allowances/Benefits:

- 2.2 Attend and facilitate presentations, workshops, and project meetings.
- 2.3 Support business development efforts, including attending meetings with potential clients, listening to new project briefs, preparing proposals, observing/analyzing project sites and buildings, etc.
- 2.4 Support project design management.
- 2.5 Liaise with owners, other consultants and authorities to meet project objectives.
- 2.6 Direct and/or cooperate with project team members to develop design ideas and solutions for assigned projects.
- 2.7 Coordinate efforts with related local authorities and Nikken Sekkei Group member departments.

3 Application Requirements

- 3.1 Age range: 26 40 years of age.

- 3.7 Knowledge of Lumion, Enscape, and Revit is a plus.
- 3.8 License(s): a license in Vietnam is preferred.

 - * Self-motivating character.
 - * Well-mannered (polite, friendly, honest, accurate and punctual).
